

One Hen Academy

The goal of One Hen is to empower students to become social entrepreneurs who make a difference for themselves and their communities through personal initiative, financial literacy, and global awareness.

One Hen's objectives are to enable educators to integrate financial literacy and social entrepreneurship into their classrooms, whether during the school day or after school. The program includes:

- The book *One Hen: How One Small Loan Made a Big Difference* which teaches students about business building through the true story of a boy in Ghana (who receives a small loan and starts a backyard chicken farm – ultimately growing his business to be the largest poultry farmer in Ghana)
- An Educator Guide
- Student Workbooks
- Supportive resources

The goals of the program are to teach students the following:

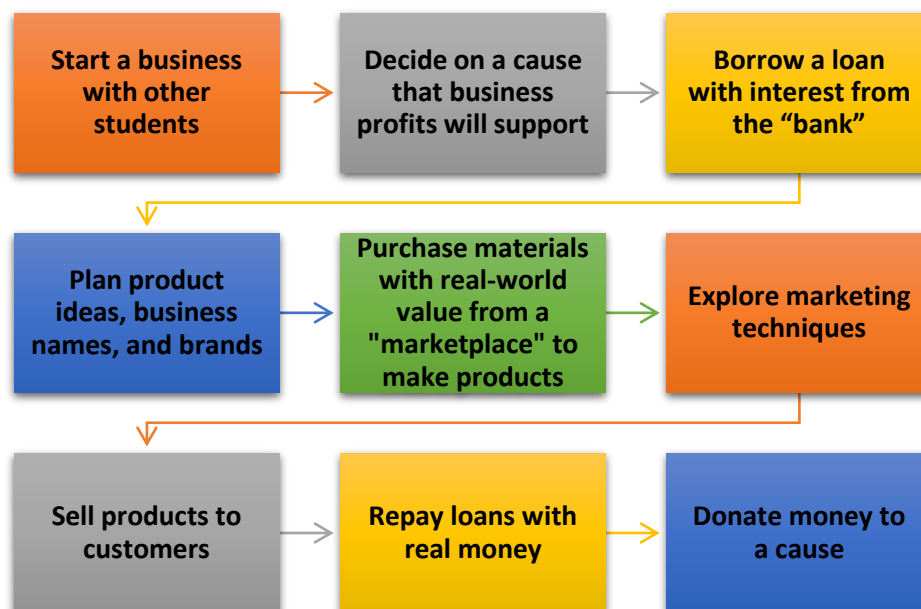
- Basic personal financial management

Timeline
